



How to use Enviro Picture Building game



The enviro picture building tool can be used to generate discussion, guide reflections and mirror what the user sees on the ground. However, a general explanation of how the tool can be used is outlined below - but these instructions can be adapted according to how the user would like to apply the tool.

STEP 1: HOW TO USE THE CARDS

(A) The Enviro picture building game should be played in a group of 5 or more people. To make the game fun, you can separate the group into 2.

- The picture building game has **picture cards (A)** which depict a picture of human activities that impact the environment either positively or negatively.
- The game also has **description cards (B)** which depict pictures of the same human activities on **card (A)** and a description of what is happening in the picture.

(B) As the facilitator of the game, you will use the **description cards (B)**, so keep these with you.

You will then hand out the **picture cards (A)** to the participants.

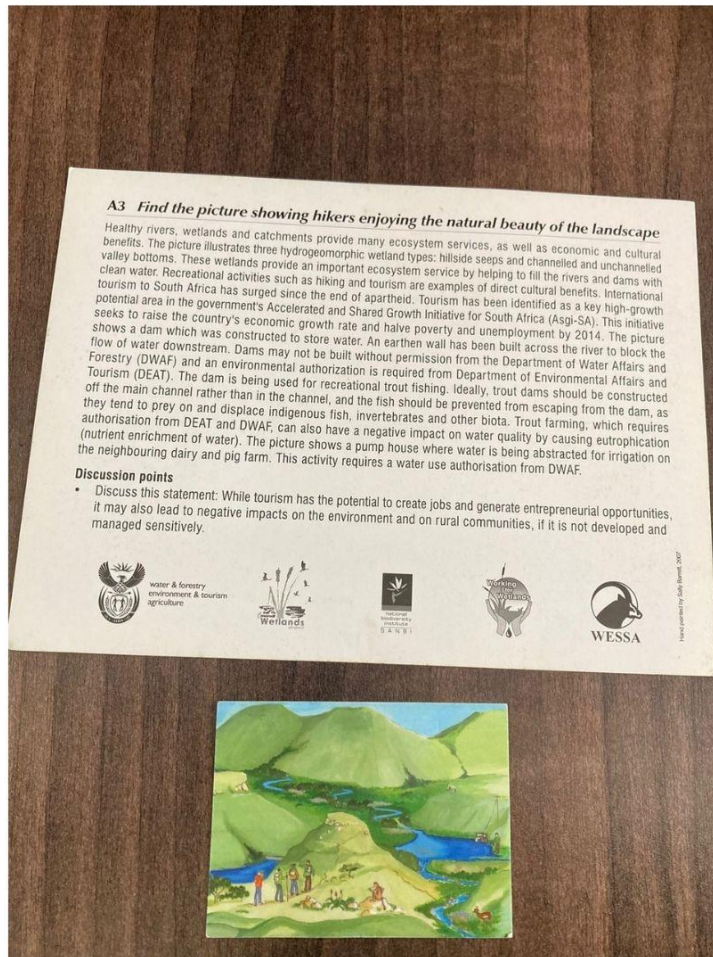
STEP 2: HOW TO PLAY THE GAME

(C) Select a card from your **description cards (B)** and describe the card to the group.

(D) From the group, the individual who has the **picture card (A)** you have described should run towards the facilitator (you) and hand over the card. Check if the card the participant has given is the correct one.

(E) Repeat this process until the cards are finished.
